LOCATION

For the 9th year, beginning on Memorial Day (Monday, May 26, 2025) and running through Labor Day, the notes of "Taps" will once more fill the air every evening as the famous 24-note call is sounded at the Pennsylvania Monument in Gettysburg National Military Park

(Location: The monument is located south of Gettysburg, on Hancock Avenue at Pleasonton Avenue, which is also a stop on the Gettysburg Battlefield Tour (Tour #12).

Taps is a solemn honor to those who have died in service to our country and to those who have and are still serving in uniform today. Please make every effort to perform this call in a dignified manner. Please refer to the guidelines of sounding Taps found at https://tapsbugler.com/taps-performance-guidelines/ Pay particular attention to the correct rhythm of Taps. We wish to be consistent in all the performances.

PLEASE DRESS APPROPRIATELY

Military or Civilian dress (appropriate clothes please). Business casual, at the least, is appropriate. It's wiser to dress on the conservative side rather than underdressed. If you wear a military uniform, veteran service organization, band uniform or any outfit representing a group, please wear the uniform in keeping with rules and regulations governing the wear.
